WayEdit

The following shows the steps needed to create a text file containing fares, so they can be imported into a Waycon Service.

Lets overwrite the fares in Service 100 with the fares in Service 200.

Back-up the Waycon Project, before continuing.

Create the Text File

Open Service 200.

In Print Menu, select and execute 'Print to File'.

Close WayEdit.

Prepare for Import of Text File

Get file 'C:\Program Files\Walkden\Project\Ref Fares\200.txt

(Note: Project is the name of your Waycon Project)

Rename the 200.txt file to 100.far

Create a 'FarFiles' folder in the Project folder.

Import the Fares

Place the 100.far file in the FarFares folder.

Execute Wayedit and open Service 100.

Hold down the Alt-key while Right-click the Update Button.

You will be asked if you want to Import, click-on Yes

The changes won't be saved, unless you Save them yourself.

If Import was successful the file in the FarFiles folder will have been deleted, therefore, if you need to keep this data, back it up.

A Text file containing fares must be triangular.

**The two Fare-tables should be the same size,
although this is not obligatory.**

The size of the fare-table being overwritten will not change.

**Provided the fares in the text file conform to the structure of the
'Print to File' output, any file can be used to overwrite fares in a service.**

Always back-up the Waycon Project, before updating.
